

## Island Grown in the San Juans Producer Member Pledge

Farm, Forage, Fisher and Value-added Businesses or Individual Products

Island Grown in the San Juans is a branding program that celebrates the quality, bounty, and benefits of food and products grown, raised, made or gathered in San Juan County, Washington. The Island Grown program benefits the farms and farmers that grow and gather local products, and the businesses that use them by increasing production and consumption of local products. The program also educates consumers in the benefits of a sustainable local food system and encourages them to support farms and businesses that use local products creating a healthy local food system.

Island Grown defines "local" as:

- Produce grown in San Juan County
- Livestock and meat products derived from animals that have spent at least 50% of their lives in San Juan County
- o Products wild-harvested in San Juan County
- Value-added products for which at least 75% of the defining ingredient(s) and/or labor was derived from San Juan County

## Island Grown Producers Pledge

As an Island Grown producer, I pledge to:

- Meet the Island Grown definition of "local"
- Produce crops and livestock that are free of Genetically Modified Organisms (GMOs), in compliance with San Juan County GMO-Free Initiative Measure 2012-4
- Comply with all relevant local, state, and federal regulations
- Use environmentally friendly practices whenever possible
- Acknowledge Island Grown local product(s) in value-added ingredients list
- Package and display *Island Grown* product(s) prominently, cleanly, and attractively
- Promote Island Grown as a brand and use Island Grown products whenever possible
- (For value-added products) Agree to report as best we can our "Island Grown" food budget % of
  what we used the previous year, and what we plan to use for the coming year for our valueadded products, to San Juan Islands Agricultural Guild each spring to uphold the integrity of the
  program, and to help promote the value of buying and eating local
